About the RIA Certified Robot Integrator Program

The RIA Certified Robot Integrator is a mark reserved for robot system integrators who meet industry best practices. The Robotic Industries Association (RIA) developed this program at the request of end-users of robots and integrators to set industry benchmarks. The RIA Certification is the only program of its kind.

Using input from end-users, robot manufacturers, component suppliers and the integrators themselves, RIA developed the Robotic Integrator Scorecard that spells out the benchmarks. The scorecard is available for complimentary download on robotics.org and provides a weighted score based on 25 different criteria including, quality, risk assessments, number of robot integrations, engineering and programming capabilities just to name a few.

After completing the scorecard, system integrators may apply for certification after which they are audited by a third party for compliance to the program. If they pass they are allowed to declare themselves a RIA Certified Robot Integrator. They are retested by the auditors every two years to maintain the certification.
